## Overview

The Lancaster County Academy offers the opportunity for students to earn a Math, English, or Social Studies credit to apply towards high school graduation requirements. The self-paced courses, offered in the regular Academy curriculum, are designed to be completed primarily in the classroom. These are not correspondence or online courses; however, some courses have online components. **A certified teacher is available to guide the student and offer assistance in course completion.** All tests or graded assignments must be completed at the Academy. LCA course requirements must be completed to earn the credit.

The Academy is open seven hours Monday-Friday and the student can set a flexible schedule during the summer session. **Students can adjust attendance hours to accommodate public bus schedules, family vacation time or summer work schedules.**

To complete a course in the summer session, a minimum of 10 hours per week of attendance is recommended. More time spent in class may accelerate course completion.

All course work must be finished by August 18, 2017 to earn credit for the course. Students and their school are provided with documentation of course completion and grade.

## Guidelines

The goal is to help you. We take pride in our adult learning environment. We ask that you not bother other students with questions. *Ask the staff.* Inappropriate conduct is handled on a case-by-case basis. You may be required to change your seat or to leave the classroom if you are interfering with the learning of others.

The following will be grounds for dismissal from the summer school program:

- *Possession of or being under the influence of drugs and/or alcohol*
- *Fighting, verbal or physical abuse of a staff member or other student*
- *Theft or destruction of LCA property. Students will be held financially responsible for any intentional damage*
