



NOTICE OF SCHOOL CLOSURE FROM LANCASTER COUNTY ACADEMY

March 14, 2020

Given the continual evolution of the coronavirus (COVID-19) outbreak, Lancaster County Academy (LCA) has been monitoring the guidance provided by health officials and the Pennsylvania (PA) Department of Education.

Yesterday, Governor Wolf announced the closure of all K-12 PA school districts for the next 10 business days. Consequently, LCA and our eight participating schools will be closed March 16-27, 2020.

LCA remains committed to educating each learner during this time. As such, the Academy has developed plans to provide learners with educational resources for continued learning, which will be made available on the [Academy's webpage](#) on Monday, March 16.

At this time, the Academy is not equipped to provide opportunities for students to work on all courses at a distance. LCA staff are currently identifying coursework for select classes that students can work on outside of the classroom. Our self-paced curriculum and flexible schedule will allow interested students to exceed the minimum attendance requirement when we can re-open.

The Academy will continue to monitor the guidance of health officials and the PA Department of Education, as well as the actions of our sending schools. We will communicate additional information via the One Call Now phone system as new updates become available. We will also maintain proactive communication with our host, HACC Lancaster.
