

SCHOOL CLOSURE UPDATE FROM LANCASTER COUNTY ACADEMY

We sincerely hope this correspondence finds you in good health. This week, HACC's leadership team determined campuses will remain closed through May 17; however, Lancaster County Academy (LCA) is scheduled to re-open to students on April 9. We will maintain communication with HACC officials to determine the feasibility of this tentative return date.

On March 23, we invited all students to complete the following survey: <u>LCA</u> <u>Remote Coursework Survey</u>. The survey results will be shared with our teachers to address the needs of each learner. We encourage all students to take a few minutes to complete it.

On March 12-13, teachers worked with students to develop individual plans on how they could continue coursework in the event LCA was asked to close. We recognize not all families have the equipment to engage in the remote coursework posted on <u>our website</u>. In response, we are developing mobile-friendly opportunities for students with access to a mobile device and the Internet.
